in 1987 our first book acupuncture textbook and atlas received rave reviews e g in new england journal of medicine this prompted us to write this smaller affordable version in order to reach a wider audience the smaller format has been so successful that we are now into our third revised edition this has given us the opportunity to update and improve the book for example numerous new references to scientific advances have been added also the section on traditional chinese medicine tcm was added because it gives a more complete picture of the current practice of acupuncture acupuncture has come a long way since our first book in
